The first version, AutoCAD R20, was released in 1987. Version 1 was the first to be distributed as a Mac application, due to Mac users being underserved by the AutoCAD Windows PC and DOS applications. In 1994, Autodesk acquired Albrecht Software, which was founded in 1984 and specialized in drafting software. AutoCAD was upgraded in 1995. AutoCAD uses embedded Autodesk Media and Entertainment (Ame) services to add native video, streaming, podcasts, and music to AutoCAD for a flat annual fee. The AutoCAD 360 subscription model was dropped in favor of a yearly charge beginning on April 24, 2014. AutoCAD 360 was renamed to AutoCAD 2018 on April 24, 2017. This new version introduced several major changes, most notably the introduction of the Universal Windows Platform and the ability to work with Microsoft Windows (instead of the Windows-only WYSIWYG UI). This release also had a number of backwards incompatible changes to the user interface and commands. It also dropped support for 32-bit versions of Microsoft Windows.
