

How to Use e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18 as a Virtual Webcam

e2esoft VCam is a virtual webcam software that enables you to emulate a webcam in your system and use it with various applications that require a webcam, such as video conferencing, video broadcasting, video teaching, remote education, video chatting, and more^[1]. In this article, we will show you how to use e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18 as a virtual webcam on your Windows PC.

Step 1: Download and Install e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18

You can download e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18 from the official website^[1] or from other software download sites^[3]. The installation process is simple and straightforward. Just follow the instructions on the screen and accept the license agreement. You may need to restart your computer after the installation is complete.

Step 2: Launch e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18 and Select a Video Source

After installing e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18, you can launch it from the Start menu or the desktop shortcut. You will see the main interface of the software, which consists of four tabs: Video Source, Video Effect, Settings, and About. The Video Source tab allows you to select a video source for your virtual webcam. You can choose from various options, such as:

- Your real webcam
- A video file
- A picture file
- Your desktop screen
- A blank image
- A playlist of videos or pictures

You can also adjust the brightness, contrast, saturation, hue, and flip of the video source.

Step 3: Apply Video Effects to Your Virtual Webcam

The Video Effect tab allows you to apply various effects to your virtual webcam, such as:

- Text overlay
- Image overlay
- Face tracking
- Motion detection
- Color adjustment
- Distortion
- Blur
- Mosaic

- Noise
- Edge detection
- Emboss
- Invert color
- Grayscale
- Sketch
- Oil painting
- Cartoon

You can also create your own custom effects by using the Effect Editor.

Step 4: Configure Settings for Your Virtual Webcam

The Settings tab allows you to configure various settings for your virtual webcam, such as:

- The output resolution and frame rate
- The audio source and volume
- The hotkeys for switching video sources and effects
- The watermark for your virtual webcam
- The update check and feedback options
- The registration information and license code

Step 5: Use Your Virtual Webcam with Any Application That Supports Webcam

The About tab shows you some information about the software version, website, support, and feedback. Now that you have set up your virtual webcam with e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18, you can use it with any application that supports webcam, such as Skype, Zoom, Google Meet, Discord, OBS Studio, Streamlabs OBS, etc. To use your virtual webcam with an application, just select "e2eSoft VCam" as your webcam device in the application settings. You can also switch between different video sources and effects by using the hotkeys that you configured in the Settings tab. If you want to enjoy more features of e2esoft VCam 5.1.0.18, such as multi-camera support, chroma keying, picture-in-picture mode, etc., you can purchase a license code from the official website^[1]. The license code can be used for one year or permanently



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
